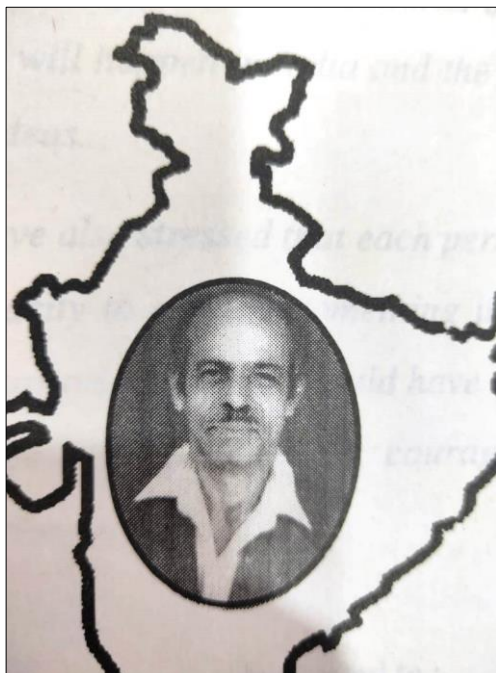


R T KRISHNA (1938 to 2017)

Author RT Krishna was born in 1938 in Malleswaram, Bangalore to Sri R Tirunarayana Iyengar of Ramanujapuram Anandapillai family of two sons and three daughters. His maternal grandfather was late S.
