


M. C. VARADACHAR (1894 – 1970)

Sri Mandayam Chakravarthy (M. C.) Varadachar was born to Sri MC Srinivasa Iyengar of Kovil Vashal family and Smt. Tirumalamma of Gramani family. His family was called Kovil Vashal family since his grandfather MC Varadachar, lived next to Sri Lakshmi Janardhana Swamy Temple in Mandya Town.



He was married to Smt. Alumelamma from Tondanur Prativaadibhayankaram family. He had a large family of brothers and a sister and also he had 8 sons and 2 daughters, whom he brought up very well with meagre resources.

After passing SAS, he joined as an accountant at the Govt. Secretariat Department and retired in 1949 as Asst. Accountant. After retirement he joined Indian Institute of Science as an Internal Auditor for about 5 years.

He was the Secretary to Ubhaya Vendantha Pravarthana Sabha, Malleswaram, Bangalore, for about 15 years and during this period translated to Kannada, Sri Raamaanuja Nootandaadi by Tiruvangattha Mudanaararra.

He was very active in overseeing Vedic and Prabhandam classes and examinations conducted by Ubhaya Vendantha Pravarthana Sabha both in Bangalore and Melkote to which place he used to travel by bus.

Sri M C Varadachar passed away in 1970 peacefully after a brief illness.
