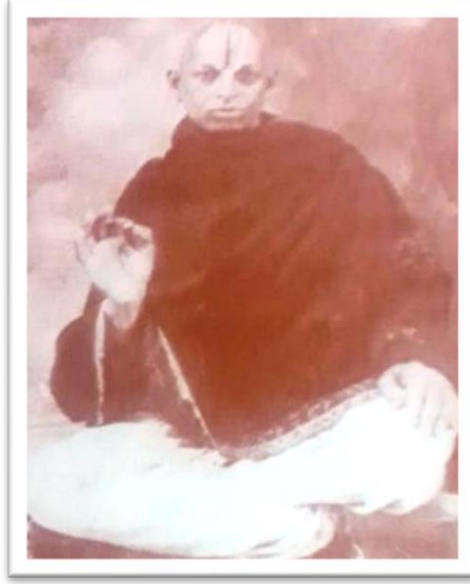


M.T. NARSIMHACHARYA (1867-1935)



M.T. Narsimhacharya was born in 1867 to Sri. Singlacharya of Mandayam Todanur Pratiwadibhayankaram family, and Smt. Singamma of Melukote. He knew Kannada, English, Tamil and Sanskrit and could write good poetry in these languages.

He wrote works under the pseudonym 'Kalki Bhagavathsimha'.

Apart from writing works such as 'Kathamala', 'Gitarthasaramritha', 'Anantharya Saccharihamritham', 'Jnanamrithatarangini', he translated Anatharya Saccharithamritham' as 'Ananthrayvybhava' into Kannada and incorporated it in 'Parivarithya Rathnamala'.

He has a few original works in Kannada as well. The author has written many books on Daily Rituals for a Srivaishnava translated from Tamil, as follows:
